(Initial) Scholarship male dancers must be at an advanced level – red or black belt and taking ballet class at least 3 or more times per week. Scholarship students must maintain an enthusiastic and supportive attitude and serve as role models for younger students. Scholarship male dancers must participate in all company productions, including spring company concert, the Nutcracker and various lecture demos performed throughout the school year, and help at the recital in spring. Scholarship male dancers are expected to study throughout the school year and summer. Student teaching is a full school year commitment and should be treated as a job.
(Initial) I acknowledge that teachers and administrative staff, including board members who are also on the teaching or administrative staff, are barred from selecting scholarship recipients. Teacher input is considered only regarding the student's progress and performance during class time.
